

# 3.7 APPLYING ETHICAL PRINCIPLES


#### 1. DEFINE THE ISSUE 2. SEEK ADVICE

Reflect honestly on the choices available in light of the results that are likely to occur




### 4. PRAY FOR GOD'S GUIDANCE
