12A: RELIGIONS OF THE WORLD

By the end of this topic, students will be able to:

1. Describe the nature and purpose of religion
2. Identify some features of some Pacific traditional religions and some major Religions of the world
3. Discuss 'religion' in the light of the teaching of Vatican II
4. Explain the significance for Christians of studying other religions
