- A SPECIAL CEREMONY TO FREE THE SPIRIT FROM THE BODY AND ASSIST IT ON ITS WAY TO THE SPIRIT WORLD



## **QUESTION TWO**

- MAORI VIEW OF THE UNIVERSE IS THAT THERE IS A LINK BETWEEN THE MATERIAL AND SPIRITUAL WORLDS
- THE COMMUNITY SHARES IN THE GRIEF
- TIMES OF SERIOUS ILLNESS, DEATH AND GRIEF ARE MOST SACRED MOMENTS IN MAORI LIFE.

- - TANGI LASTS TWO/THREE DAYS, SHOWING THE RESPECT FOR THE DECEASED
- THE FUNERAL SERVICE IS IN MAORI CONSISTS OF KARAKIA, HYMNS, SCRIPTURE READINGS AND SERMON
- -ONCE THE BURIAL IS OVER THE TAKAHI WHARE(TRAMPING OF THE HOUSE) TAKES PLACE TO REMOVE THE TAPU
