QUESTION ONE

- MAORI BELIEFS VARY DEPENDING ON THEIR IWI AND RELEVANT TRADITIONAL STORIES
- -ALL HUMANS DIE INEVITABLY
- -AT DEATH, MAURI (LIFE FORCE) DIES AND DISAPPEARS
- TUKU WAIRUA CEREMONY – KARAKIA THAT: PURIFIES AND CLEANSSES THE SPIRIT OF THE DECEASED PRIOR TO JOINING THE SPIRITS OF THE ANCESTORS AND GODS.
- A SPECIAL CEREMONY TO FREE THE SPIRIT FROM THE BODY AND ASSIST IT ON ITS WAY TO THE SPIRIT WORLD

QUESTION TWO

- MAORI VIEW OF THE UNIVERSE IS THAT THERE IS A LINK BETWEEN THE MATERIAL AND SPIRITUAL WORLDS
- THE COMMUNITY SHARES IN THE GRIEF
- - TIMES OF SERIOUS ILLNESS, DEATH AND GRIEF ARE MOST SACRED MOMENTS IN MAORI LIFE.
- - IMPORTANT BECAUSE IT CREATES HOPE FOR THE MEMBERS WHO HAVE LOST THEIR LOVED ONES

QUESTION THREE

- - TANGI LASTS TWO/THREE DAYS, SHOWING THE RESPECT FOR THE DECEASED
- - THE FUNERAL SERVICE IN MAORI CONSISTS OF KARAKIA, HYMNS, SCRIPTURE READINGS AND SERMON
- -ONCE THE BURIAL IS OVER THE TAKAHI WHARE(TRAMPING OF THE HOUSE) TAKES PLACE TO REMOVE THE TAPU
